Student Dress Code

HIS Kids Christian School respects the rights of students and their parents to make decisions regarding their appearance, except when their choices affect the educational program of the schools, or the health and safety of themselves and/or others. Students' attire should reflect school and personal pride.

- HIS Kids apparel is always appropriate and can be purchased on the school website: www.hiskidcs.org.
- We promote a modest dress code at HIS Kids. This means that no shirts with spaghetti straps, tank-tops, or skin-tight clothing will be permitted.
- Students should not wear articles of clothing which are inappropriately designed, contain offensive and/or inappropriate logos, iron-ons, emblems, decorations and words. If you are not sure whether something is offensive and/or inappropriate, a good rule of thumb is **not to wear it!**
- Shorts are permitted to be worn, however, short shorts are not permitted. Please use modest guidelines—no shorter than fingertip length when standing with arms down at the sides. Cut-off shorts with frayed or slit bottoms are not acceptable. When the student sits or bends over, undergarments should not be seen.
- Skirts and dresses should reach modest lengths. No mini skirts. Again, use the fingertip “rule”, as well as, when the student sits or bends over, undergarments should not be seen.
- Clothing that reveals or exposes the midriff, lower back, chest, sides of upper body or undergarments should not be worn.
- Due to safety concerns, no flip-flops, nor “heelies” (footwear with any type of wheels) may be worn to school.
- Due to safety concerns, tennis shoes are required for gym class. If a student does not have the appropriate footwear on gym day, they will not be allowed to participate.
- Students are expected to remove hats/caps and hoods while in the school building.
- Students are expected to remove sunglasses while in the school building.

It will be at the discretion of HIS Kids Christian School to decide if an outfit is deemed to be following the above mentioned school policy. If the school policy has not been adhered to, the parent/guardian will be notified to bring a change of clothes for their child(ren). The child will be removed from the rest of the student body until proper adjustments have been made to inappropriate clothing (i.e., change of clothes, turn shirt inside out).
